I am writing this open letter because I believe my public notoriety is being used tactfully to systematically destroy my reputation. I have worked in this community for many years and gladly sacrificed time, personal finances, and goodwill all in an effort to showcase what I believe to be the best our community has to offer. I have not done this in isolation but have worked alongside countless volunteers who have invested their own blood, sweat and tears for a good that transcends and a purpose that we hope elevates people.

The court of public opinion will not be where this fight takes place for me and my house, although others have taken to such means. I only ask that my work in the community, the lives we have impacted, and my reliance on the process speak for me at a time when I have been advised to remain silent.
